

SANUKI Program

Japanese Language & Culture Study at Kagawa University, Japan Fall Semester 2017

SANUKI Program is a one semester program for students who wish to learn Japanese language and Japanese culture with a focus on Kagawa Prefecture ('Sanuki' is the old name for 'Kagawa').

Sample courses

Elementary Japanese classes: Students learn basic skills of the language: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. By mastering Japanese alphabet and basic expressions, students can start communicating with Japanese people in Japanese, which will make life in Kagawa more fun and comfortable.

Japanese Official Development Assistance toward developing countries: Introduces the Japanese Official Development Assistance program while highlighting the importance of international cooperation based upon the Japanese experience in developing technologies through human relationships.

Project Sanuki: A research-based course whereby international students work with Japanese students on issues related to Sanuki. Topics can be on geography, history, food, culture, tourist attractions, industries, or Sanuki-dialect.

Globalization in the Higher Education Sector: Focuses on how the higher education sector is affected by globalization through the movements of students across borders.

Japanese Songs: Students learn to sing a Japanese song, after which they perform at the Closing Ceremony.

Japanese Cuisine: Students learn the basics of Japanese cuisine, from essential ingredients such as miso and soy sauce to basic cooking techniques like making dashi. This class gives students the chance to taste some dishes and practical elements.

Language

Students are required to have communicative skills in English. Prior knowledge of Japanese Language is not required.

Application Procedure

STEP 1

Consult with staff in charge of international affairs in your university and submit the following documents (electronic format) via international office of your university. We may need the original documents at a later date.

【Required documents from students】

- Essay on reasons to apply (*Form will be provided)
- CV (free format)

【Required documents from partner universities】

- Certificate of enrollment through March 2018
- Nomination Letter (issued by director or dean)
- Academic transcript

STEP 2

We will notify you on whether your application is accepted by the end of July. After receiving a letter of acceptance, send us the following:

- Application of Certificate of Eligibility (to apply for student visa) (*Form will be provided)
- Application form for exchange student (*Form will be provided)
- Certificate of scholarship (for private students, bank account etc.)
- Health Certificate
- Copy of passport

We shall advise you on flight reservations in due time. Please do not purchase your air ticket before our advice.

Accommodation

University dormitories are available. We shall make a reservation for you.

Costs

Tuition for Sanuki Program is waived for students from partner universities.

However, students shall bear airfares, dorm fees, health insurance and any other living expenses.

Approximate living cost is US\$500 (JPY¥60,000) per month.
