八、申請流程	<p>(二)國內複選：</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.書面審查：經本部審查後函復推薦學校審查結果，符合申請資格者由推薦學校轉達面試通知單。 2.面試：115年3月7日或8日，採線上面試方式，由本部聘請面試委員對符合申請資格者進行面試，擇優錄取；面試原則以英語、捷語或其他斯拉夫語進行(實際面試時間將另行通知)。 3.評審標準(總分100分)： <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1)書面資料：包括在校學業成績、個人經歷與傑出表現、履歷等，占25分。 (2)人品與態度：包括儀表、禮貌、態度舉止、涵養等，占25分。 (3)言詞與表達能力：包括思考與反應、言語表達、外文能力、邏輯概念等，占25分。 (4)學識與見解：學識及時事的見解，占25分。 4.甄選結果：115年3月中旬由本部函知推薦學校。正、備取學生須至網站：https://studujnavs.gov.cz/aktivita/108，上傳申請所需文件(以PDF格式，網站開放時間自3月15日至4月15日止，逾時不候。) <p>(三)夏令營主辦大學審核：甄選產生之名單，俟轉交捷克教育部後，將由捷克各院校進行審核，並對最終錄取結果有自主權。捷克各院校將於本年5月至7月直接聯繫正取生及相關備取生。收到錄取通知者，務請回復校方確認是否參加，並電郵副知捷克教育部承辦人(電郵信箱：Magdalena.VillatoroSladkova@msmt.cz)。倘受獎生確認參加後因故無法成行，務請立即通知國內推薦學校、捷克夏令營主辦大學及捷克教育部承辦人，以利進行遞補作業。</p>

Summer Schools of Slavonic Studies 2026



Scholarships to attend the Summer Schools of Slavonic Studies, which offer intensive courses of the Czech language and culture.

The Summer Schools of Slavonic Studies are three- to four-week Czech language courses organized by several public universities in the Czech Republic, which take place annually in July and August. Their duration ranges from 3 to 4 weeks. The length of the course is determined by the organizing school.

The courses are intended chiefly for foreign students, experts (teachers, translators, interpreters) and academics in the field of Czech and Slavic studies who are at least 18 years old. However, due to their broad scope, they are also open to everyone else interested in the Czech language, literature, history and culture.

The Summer Schools of Slavonic Studies offer Czech language courses at various levels of proficiency, seminars focused on the Czech literature, culture, and history, leisure activities including theatre, music, and dance performances, excursions, sightseeing trips, etc.

In 2026, applicants, who are at least 18 years old, from the following countries and territories can apply for an SSSS scholarship:

Albania, Austria, Belgium – Flemish Community, Belgium – French Community, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Canada (Alberta), People's Republic of China, Croatia, Denmark, Egypt, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, India, Israel, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Mongolia, Montenegro, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Korea, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, Ukraine, the United Kingdom, the USA, and Vietnam.

The scholarships are granted ONLY to candidates nominated by the appropriate authorities of the partner countries or by other authorized nominating agencies, e.g. the Embassies of the Czech Republic abroad and other partner institutions (see below).

These institutions specify the conditions for participation in the selection procedure and can provide detailed information on the offer of summer school courses.

The number of scholarship slots and their distribution among individual summer schools are determined by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports.

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

The courses are taught in Czech or on the basis of English, depending on the participant's initial level of Czech language proficiency.

The SSSS program includes courses of all language proficiency levels: from absolute beginners (A0) to advanced students (C1).

HOW TO APPLY

A two-step screening and selection procedure is applied to assess applications for the summer school scholarships provided by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic.

1. The first stage is organized by the respective Embassies of the Czech Republic, partner ministries or other government agencies responsible for student exchanges in the eligible countries. The applicants are required to file their completed application forms for the summer school scholarships and other documents, if they are required, with the relevant institutions accepting applications in the eligible countries, which then select the nominees for scholarship awards.

A CV written in Czech or English must be attached to the completed application form. The institutions receiving applications may also require other documents (e.g. a letter of motivation, language certificate(s) etc.).

The application includes also a statement that the applicant is able to participate in the entire period of the SSSS course concerned.

The application form with the required attachments must be submitted to the appropriate institution receiving applications:

The relevant deadline is fixed by the appropriate institution receiving applications in each country/territory.

The nomination of candidates, who are recommended for the scholarship awards (referred to also as the "nominees" below) must be presented by the appropriate institutions in the eligible countries to the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports **by 31 March 2026**.

2. The second stage is organized by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports and the relevant Czech universities. The nominees are obliged to register themselves in the online registration system and submit an online scholarship application: <https://studujnavs.gov.cz/aktivita/108/vyzva/108>. The online applications of the registered nominees are assessed within the system by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports and the relevant Czech universities.

The outcome of the two-step process described above is either the scholarship award or placement as a substitute on a waiting list.

Applications submitted by applicants who have not been properly recommended for the awards by the relevant institutions in the eligible countries will be rejected.

SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship consists in the reimbursement of course fees and other expenses related to the accepted candidate's participation in a summer course, **which is provided the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports directly to the host university.**

The scholarship includes:

- registration and tuition fees;
- study materials;
- board and lodging (accommodation is provided in student dormitories);
- trips and events organised by the summer school concerned.

The scholarship DOES NOT cover:

- international travel costs;
- insurance;
- visa processing.

Applications sent directly to the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic (MEYS) or directly to the Summer Schools will not be processed!

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The institutions receiving scholarship applications and performing the first stage of the selection procedure recommend:

- regular nominees,
- substitutes (up to twice as many as regular nominees).

The institutions receiving applications deliver their nomination to the MEYS **by 31 March 2026**.

The successful candidates will be then invited to register in the online application system and will be subsequently contacted by the relevant Summer School organizer.

Each successful candidate is obliged to confirm his/her participation promptly to the organizer of the Summer School concerned.

The MEYS reserves the right to place any candidate at a different Summer School than the one mentioned as the first choice in his/her application.

RESIGNATION / WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION

If any of the officially nominated and admitted SSSS participants is unable to attend the course due to unforeseen reasons, he/she is **obliged to inform** the MEYS Department of International Relations and EU **without delay, sending a message to Magdalena.VillatoroSladkova@msmt.gov.cz**, as well as **to the relevant Summer School** so that a substitute can be contacted immediately.

If the scholarship quota (regular nominees and substitutes) offered to any given partner country/territory at one of the Summer Schools is not utilized, it is possible to provide the free slots to substitutes from other eligible countries.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Health insurance is NOT included in the scholarship. It is strongly recommended that successful candidates arrange their travel health insurance for the entire period of their visit to the Czech Republic. More information can be provided by the Czech Embassy in the candidate's country of residence or country of origin.

Medical care for **EU/EEA citizens and citizens of the United Kingdom and Switzerland**, who are properly insured in their home countries, is provided in compliance with the European Parliament and Council (EC) Regulation No. 883/2004, as last amended, and its implementing Regulation No. 987/2009, as amended by Regulation No. 465/2012 - detailed information is available on the website of the [Health Insurance Bureau](#).

Please note that the expenses for repatriation are not covered by the provisions of the aforementioned European Regulations, and it is therefore advisable to obtain an insurance policy to this end even if you come from an EU/EEA country, United Kingdom or Switzerland.

Neither the MEYS nor the universities organizing the SSSS bear any responsibility or liability for any health care costs or repatriation costs that may be incurred by the scholarship-holders during or as a result of their visit to the Czech Republic.

VISAS

It is recommended that both the regular nominees and substitutes from non-EU/EEA countries apply for their visas well in advance.

Detailed information about the Summer Schools of Slavonic Studies (SSSS) is available on the website of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports (MEYS) of the Czech Republic.

1. Announcement of scholarship offer

Kindly inform the local academic communities, especially the departments of Czech and Slavonic/Slavic studies, about the SSSS, and publish information about the scholarship offer on your website so that it reaches as many strong candidates as possible. Please set the deadline by which candidates should submit their applications to your office.

2. Selection of scholarship recipients and substitutes

Candidates fill in the application form and send it together with their CVs to the embassy or another institution conducting the selection procedure before the deadline. The selection of scholarship recipients is **entirely** within the terms of reference of the embassy or the partner institution concerned. The MEYS respects their nomination, and no further selection procedure takes place. Please inform **all** applicants after the selection procedure, whether they have been successful or not, and to which summer school they have been assigned.

3. Nomination of scholarship recipients and substitutes

Before presenting the nomination to the MEYS, please check carefully that the candidates are at least 18 years old and that they are assigned to a school featuring on the list of slots offered to the partner country concerned. The schools and the number of scholarship slots are specified in the cover letter. Applicants who were not selected for scholarship positions may be nominated as substitutes.

4. Submitting nominations to the MEYS

Please send the list of nominated candidates and substitutes, in the following format, to the MEYS, Department of International Relations and the European Union, or to Magdalena.VillatoroSladkova@msmt.gov.cz, by **March 31, 2026**:

5. Online registration

The embassy or another partner institution will instruct **the selected scholarship recipients and substitutes** to register online at <https://studujnavs.gov.cz/aktivita/108>. Registration for the SSSS will be open from **March 15 to April 15, 2026**. We recommend that the nominated scholarship recipients and substitutes fill out the online application as soon as possible.

6. Submitting nominations to the MEYS

The MEYS will check the applications in the system, approve them based on the nominations received, and forward them to the relevant summer schools, which will then contact the scholarship recipients and substitutes.

Selection procedure

- Phase 2 (takes place within the [Studujnavs.gov.cz](https://studujnavs.gov.cz) portal)



- March 15, 2026: opening of the online registration system
- March 31, 2026: deadline for submitting the nominations to the MEYS
- April 2026: review of applications by the MEYS and their submission to the organizing schools
- May, June, July 2026: schools contact scholarship recipients and substitutes

4. SELECTION PROCEDURE

A two-step selection procedure is applied to assess applications for the summer school scholarships provided by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic.

- 1. The first stage** is organized by the respective Embassies of the Czech Republic, partner ministries or other government agencies responsible for student exchanges in the eligible countries, which collect applications and then select the nominees for scholarship awards.
- 2. The second stage** is organized by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports and the relevant Czech universities. **Successful candidates are obliged to register in the online registration system and submit an online scholarship application.** The online applications of registered nominees are assessed within the system by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports and the relevant Czech universities.

5. INFORMATION ABOUT SUMMER SCHOOLS OF SLAVONIC STUDIES

Courses are delivered either exclusively in Czech or in a combination of Czech and English, contingent upon the participant's initial level of Czech language proficiency.

Period of Scholarship and Benefits: The scholarship is provided in the form of **free board and lodging, coverage of the course fees** (tuition and registration fees), and other benefits which are an integral part of the course programme. A scholarship holder will be provided with free board, lodging and other benefits covered by the scholarship only during the period of course offered by the respective Summer School.

Health insurance is NOT provided to scholarship holders, who are therefore advised to arrange their own medical insurance for the duration of their stay in the Czech Republic. Additional information can be obtained from the consular section of the Czech Embassy in your country. The EU/EEA medical insurance system is described on the website of the [Health Insurance Bureau](#); the United Kingdom and Switzerland are also included. Please note, however, that expenses for repatriation are not covered by the provisions of the aforementioned EU regulations, and it is therefore advisable to obtain an insurance policy for this purpose.

Visa – Information on the conditions of entry and residence of foreign nationals in the Czech Republic is available on the [website](#) of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic.

The scholarship holders are obliged, once they receive information on their acceptance, to confirm their willingness to utilize the scholarship and their slot on the course concerned by sending a message to the relevant contact person at the Summer School concerned. If an admitted scholarship holder cannot attend the Summer School, he/she is obliged to immediately inform the respective Summer School contact person.



