Target of teaching:

I Ching is one of the most primitive of the ancient Chinese classic. In addition to important things of Ching divination system, the full impact of the then acting aristocracy and life, I Ching scriptures a lot of Yin record, and Zhou dynasties, historical data, also modern history of China during ancient times an important medium. Besides, the shaped frame and construction process in I Ching hold the knowledge of ancient Han Chinese theory of cosmology, ontology and cosmology. We can further understand the Chinese Cultural Circle today values and culture, life view of the origin and history by analyzing of the cognitive and conceptual discussion.

Based on the above premise, this course will be described in four directions:
