



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement made and executed by and between:

The **CENTRAL LUZON STATE UNIVERSITY**, College of Veterinary Science and Medicine a higher education institution duly established by virtue of Republic Act No. 4067; with principal office address at Science City of Muñoz, Nueva Ecija, Philippines; represented by its President, **Dr. Evaristo A. Abella**; and hereinafter referred to as "**CLSU**"

and

The **NATIONAL CHIAYI UNIVERSITY**, College of Life Sciences a higher education institution established and operating pursuant to relevant government rules and regulations; with principal office address at No. 300, Xuefu Rd, East District, Chiayi City, Taiwan 600355, Taiwan; represented by its Dean, **Dr. She-Ching Wu**; and hereinafter referred to as "**NCYU**"

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, CLSU as a premiere higher education institution has a responsibility of developing globally-competitive, work-ready, socially-responsible and empowered human resources who value lifelong learning, as clearly articulated in its institutional mission;

WHEREAS, NCYU is an equal opportunity/affirmative action institution which commits to improving lives through education and research; and

WHEREAS, both CLSU and NCYU recognize the need to establish linkages with foreign academic and research institutions to enrich the academic programs they offer, strengthen their research function, and intensify the exposure of the students to different cultures thus cultivating respect and relativism.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, CLSU and NCYU do hereby agree as follows:

1. Under the existing law and other government rules and regulations of each country, both universities agree to establish linkages in various areas of academics and research on the basis of equality and reciprocity, to wit:
 - 1.1. collaborative research projects and educational activities;
 - 1.2. exchange of research data, educational materials, and academic publications;
 - 1.3. exchange of students at the undergraduate and graduate levels;
 - 1.4. exchange of faculty members, researchers and non-academic staff;
 - 1.5. sharing of facilities and related resources for instruction and research; and
 - 1.6. other areas of cooperation to be mutually agreed upon by the parties.
2. Specific details on the development and implementation of the activities enumerated above shall be negotiated and agreed by CLSU and NCYU, and must be reduced into writing via a separate Terms of Reference.
3. Each party shall designate a focal person to serve as the point of contact to manage the implementation details of each activity.

4. The expenses to be incurred in the implementation of this memorandum shall be negotiated to the mutual acceptance of both institutions. Nothing in this agreement may be construed as establishment or creation of financial responsibility of a party to another.
5. Neither university shall be liable for any failure or delay to perform its part in this memorandum when such failure is due to act of God, war, armed conflict, civil disturbance, legal restrictions, riots, insurrections, strikes, earthquake, flood, fire, pandemic disease or any cause beyond the control of the universities.
6. This memorandum shall not be construed as any transfer, assignment or infringement of any intellectual property right(s) between the two universities.
7. This memorandum shall remain in effect for five (5) years from the date of signing. This memorandum may be altered by mutual written consent of both universities at the request of either party. Modifications to this memorandum shall not become effective until they are agreed upon in writing by both universities.
8. Either party reserves the right to terminate this agreement upon six (6) months prior written notice from the date of the intended termination to effect an orderly transition or culmination of any ongoing activity contemplated under this agreement.
9. This memorandum shall be written in English, and each university shall keep a copy. Any translation in any other language shall be for reference only and shall not bind the parties.
