## 1. Participation Information

Group Requirements	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Participants must be <b>18 to 30 years old</b> (born between <b>June 7, 1995 – June 6, 2007</b>).</li><li>2. Teams must consist of <b>2–5 members</b> and may include <b>students from different schools or cross-disciplinary teams</b>.</li><li>3. <b>Team members should primarily be current students from the Changhua-Yunlin-Chiayi University Alliance</b>, but students from other universities are also welcome to participate as part of a team.</li><li>4. <b>International students</b> must provide <b>residence permits and student ID proof</b>, while <b>Taiwanese students</b> must submit their <b>National Identification Card</b> and <b>student ID</b> for verification.</li></ol>	
Important Notes	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The competition theme must be connected to the concept of a "<b>World of Three Zeros</b>" or the <b>17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)</b>. Please explain <b>which theme your proposal responds to and what social issue it aims to address</b>.</li><li>2. Each participant may <b>only register for the competition once</b> and cannot join multiple teams simultaneously.</li><li>3. Past <b>Taiwan Yunus Innovation Award winners</b> are <b>not eligible</b> to participate again.</li><li>4. This competition encourages participation from <b>international individuals and students</b>. Additional finalist spots will be allocated for both <b>Social Group</b> and <b>Student Group</b> teams that meet the <b>international participant ratio criteria</b>.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>International Participant Ratio Criteria:</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>2-member team:</b> Both members must be international participants.</li><li>• <b>3-member team:</b> Either all members are international, or <b>2 international members + 1 Taiwanese member</b>.</li><li>• <b>4-member team:</b> Either all members are international, or <b>3 international members + 1 Taiwanese member</b>.</li><li>• <b>5-member team:</b> Either all members are international, or <b>3 international members + 2 Taiwanese members</b>.</li></ul></li></ul></li><li>5. The written submission and final presentation for the competition <b>may be in either Chinese or English</b>. However, participants must inform the organizers about your primary language of presentation prior to the competition.</li></ol>	

## 2.Competition Format:

Competition phase	Date	Details
Preliminary Round	5/9   5/18	Written review phase: Judges evaluate submitted written proposals according to preliminary scoring criteria, selecting 10 teams for the finals. Teams selected at this stage receive NT\$1,000 and a merit certificate.
Semifinal & Final	5/28	Oral presentation and Q&A: Final judging panel evaluates according to final round scoring criteria.

**Note:** The final round judging panel primarily consists of professors from Changhua, Yunlin, and Chiayi University Alliance and social enterprise practice experts.

## 3.Evaluation Criteria

Preliminary Round Evaluation Criteria		
Item	Weight	Description
Feasibility of the Plan	30%	Specificity and feasibility of the practical implementation
Analysis of Social Issues	20%	Clear definition and understanding of the targeted social issues
Innovation/Uniqueness	20%	Creativity of the solution and uniqueness compared to existing products/services
Completeness of Financial Planning	15%	Realistic and comprehensive financial plan
Quality of the Written Proposal	15%	Overall quality of the submitted written proposal

Final Round Evaluation Criteria		
Item	Weight	Description
Feasibility of the Plan	30%	Methods for generating revenue and profits, and sustainability of operations
Innovation/Uniqueness	20%	Creativity of the solution and uniqueness compared to existing products/services
Maturity of Business Model	20%	Methods for generating revenue and profits
Social Impact	15%	Depth and breadth of tangible social benefits provided by solving the social issue
Quality of Proposal & Presentation	15%	Quality of the written proposal and final oral presentation

1. Teams selected from the preliminary written review will each receive NT\$1,000 and a certificate of merit.

- (1) Proof of student status, such as a valid student ID or identification document (foreign participants should provide a residence permit or passport).
- (2) A proposal submitted in PDF format (line spacing: single; font size: 12–14 pt; 5–10 pages in Word format).

The required submission materials for the semifinal round are:

- (1) The revised proposal in Word format.
- (2) A presentation file.
