Applications should be submitted to NCYU through institution's the home office. international The application deadline May 30 for September and November 30 enrollment. enrollment in February of the following year.

Admission

Applicants will be reviewed by each Faculty or Graduate School.

Eligibility

Each applicant must:

- *Agree to remain enrolled at the home institution during the exchange study period.
- *With good academic and disciplinary standing.
- *Demonstrate the level of language proficiency required for the exchange program.
- *Have a concrete purpose for studying at NCYU.

Tuition & Fee

Based on the University's student exchange agreements, exchange students will be exempted from examination fees, matriculation fees, and tuition at NCYU.

Courses

Chinese is the main language lectured at NCYU, but a number of English lectured courses are also provided each semester. Searching for the detailed course information, please visit the website of each department/ institute.

The University offers Chinese also language courses for the international students. The curriculum is designed according a balanced reading to approach which integrates meaningful language and literacy experiences with basic language skills instruction. Integrated courses in three levels (Beginner, Basic, and Intermediate) are provided.







Orientation

The orientation will be one week before the semester starts.

Health Insurance

Students are required to purchase personal health insurance before coming to NCYU. The insurance shall cover the stay in Taiwan.

Visa

- 1. Students staying less than 180 days (For students who will stay for one semester):

 If there is no plan to go abroad when studying in Taiwan, a Single Visa is sufficient that the NCYU will provide the immigration documents for visa extension to at most 6 months for free. Please be notified that it is NOT possible to change a Single Visa to a Multiple one in Taiwan.
- 2.Students staying more than 180 days (For students (one academic year study) Please apply for a Resident Visa. Within 15 days upon the first arrival in Taiwan, please apply for an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) in the National Immigration Agency. An immigration package will be provided by NCYU for obtaining your ARC.



Brief History

National Chiayi University was formed on February 1, 2000 by merging the National Chiayi Teachers College and National Chiayi Institute of Technology. The University has been regarded as the oldest and largest integrated university in the Yunlin-Chiayi area.

The university has seven colleges, including Teachers College, College of Humanities and Arts, College of Management, College of Agriculture, College of Science and Engineering, College of Life Sciences, and College of Veterinary Medicine.
